Erie High School Prom Promise 2016

Please read each of the following carefully. Initial next to each to indicate you have read, understand, and agree to the statements. This form must be completed prior to attending prom and purchasing a ticket.

I promise to behave responsibly before, during, and after Erie's Prom. I will not have illegal substances on or in my body and am aware that I will be dealt with by law officials, if deemed necessary. I understand if this occurs, I will not be refunded my money. Be alcohol and drug free!
I will follow the formal attire dress code guidelines. (1) No shorts, denim blue jeans or leggings. (2) No short sleeve shirts (polos or t-shirts). (3) Suits must include a jacket, dress pants, and a tie or scarf/bow tie. (4) Gowns must be no more than 4 inches above the knee, no lower than the level of your belly button if it were on your back, not too revealing. (5) No undergarments may be visible. (6) No ball caps or dew rags. Dress hats (i.e. cowboy hats, fedoras, top hats are allowed if part of outfit). Clothing must be appropriate for this formal event. Students will be denied admission and will not be refunded money if in violation of dress code.
Any student who does NOT attend Erie High School or is a 9th or 10th grader student at Erie High School must complete a guest form. Guest may not be older than 20 years of age. Guest forms must be turned in TWO days prior to the event to Erie High administration.
I will abide by the dance and behavior requirements, including all school rules and SVVSD polices. This is the formal event of the year and a formal atmosphere will be maintained. Any chaperone, sponsor or administrator may address any inappropriate behavior. Any behavior that is deemed to be disruptive or dangerous in nature will be addressed. Students not following these guidelines may be asked to leave the dance and maybe referred for school level discipline. Any guest asked to leave the dance will not be refunded.
Since this is a school function smoking and tobacco use of any kind is NOT permitted for anyone.
Please bring all of your needed items with you when you enter the dance. A current photo ID is required to enter the dance. You will not be allowed to go to your car/limo during the dance. If there is an emergency you will need a security or chaperone escort to and from your car/limo.
You must bring your ticket and school ID. The ticket, number, and ID will be checked at the door. Tickets are NOT transferable. Admission will begin at 8:00 pm.
In order to provide adequate time for all prom goers to get to After-Prom safely, and also to avoid any conflicts with the curfew laws of surrounding communities, the dance will conclude at 11:00 pm.
